Placing Injurious Substance on Highway  
ORDINANCE #96-02

Section 1: Placing Injurious Substance on Highway.

This ordinance is entitled; Placing Injurious Substance on Highway. The purpose is to give the Town of Hayward the authority to enforce section 346.94 (5) of the Wisconsin State Statutes.

Section 2: Placing Injurious Substances on Highways.

No person shall place or cause to be placed upon a highway any foreign substance which is or may be injurious to any vehicle or part thereof. Placing of injurious substances shall include but not be limited to pushing, blowing, pulling, throwing, dumping, or tracking snow or any other material onto or across town highways. A "vehicle" as defined in this ordinance shall have the meaning as defined in Section 344.01(2) (g), Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3: Enforcement.

The Town Chairperson, the Road Supervisor or Town Constable shall have the authority to enforce all the sections of this ordinance.

Section 4: Fines and Penalties

Any person who violates this ordinance or Section 346.94 (5) of the State Statutes shall be required to forfeit \$50.00 plus court costs for each offense, pursuant to Section 346.95 (3) of the Wisconsin State Statutes.

Section 5: Adoption.

The Town of Hayward Town Board has, by adoption of this ordinance, confirmed the specific statutory authority, powers and duties noted in the specific sections of this ordinance and has established, by these sections and this ordinance, the regulations, controls and enforcement against placing injurious substances on town highways.
