# TOWN OF HAYWARD ORDINANCE RELATING TO ISSUANCE OF PROVISIONAL OPERATORS' LICENSE

NO. 26-91

## Adopted May 7, 1991 Amended December 3, 1996

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Hayward, Sawyer County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

### Section 1:

Pursuant to Section 125.17(5) of Wisconsin Statutes, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Hayward, Sawyer County, Wisconsin hereby elects to set standards under which a Provisional License and Operators License will be issued.

## Section 2:

The Town Board shall designate the Town Clerk to have the authority to issue the Provisional License. The Town Board shall approve all such licenses at their next regular meeting.

## Section 3:

A Provisional License will be issued only to a person who has applied for an Operator's License for the first time in the Town of Hayward. A Provisional License may not be issued to any person who has been denied a license by the municipal governing body.

### Section 4:

- (a) Except as provided in par. (b), no municipal governing body may issue an Operator's License unless the applicant has successfully completed a responsible beverage server training course at any location that is offered by a vocational, technical, and adult education district and that conforms to curriculum guidelines specified by the board of vocational, technical and adult education or unless the applicant fulfills one of the following requirements:
- 1. The person is renewing an Operator's License.
- 2. Within the past 2 years, the person has completed such a training course.
- (b) A municipal governing body may issue a provisional Operator's License to a person who is enrolled in a training course under par. (a) and shall revoke that license if the applicant fails to successfully complete the course in which he/she enrolls.

#### Section 5:

The Provisional License expires 60 days after its issuance or when a permanent license for that year is issued to the holder, whichever is sooner.

## Section 6:

There will be a \$15.00 fee for the Provisional License. This fee will include the fee for the Operator's License.

#### Section 7:

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted on May 7, 1991 and amended at the Town of Hayward Town Board meeting on third day of December, 1996.
