

**Town of Hayward
Ordinance 4-03**

**An Ordinance to Repeal and Recreate the Provisions adopting the State Traffic
Code for the Town of Hayward, Wisconsin.**

Adopted November 11, 2003
Amended January 13, 2004

The Town Board for the Town of Hayward, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. State Traffic Laws Adopted. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, the statutory provision in Chapters 340-348, Wisconsin Statutes, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic, exclusive of any provisions therein relating to penalties to be imposed and exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or term of imprisonment, are adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference required or prohibited by this ordinance. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this ordinance in order to secure uniform statewide regulation of traffic on the highways, street and alleys of the State. Amended on January 13, 2004 to include Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter Trans 305 (Standards for Vehicle Equipment).

SECTION 2. State Forfeiture Statutes. Any forfeiture for violation of the State Statutes adopted by reference in Section 1 of this ordinance shall conform to the forfeiture permitted to be imposed for violation of such statutes as set forth in the Uniform Deposit and Misdemeanor Bail Schedule of the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, including any variations or increases for subsequent offenses, which schedule is adopted by reference.

SECTION 3. In addition to the forfeitures set forth in Section 2 above, defendant shall be liable through the Sawyer County Courts for the costs of prosecution, including attorney fees incurred.

SECTION 4. Invalidity of one or more of the sections of this ordinance or any section incorporated herein by reference shall not invalidate the remaining sections hereof.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication pursuant to law.
